- i. Community Center social room décor upgrade
- j. Community Center kitchen upgrade
- k. Library facility review of layout and materials
- 1. Review traffic/visibility issues at Casey's corner
- m. Investigate licensing of four/three-wheelers on city streets

2. CITIZEN QUICK KILLS (can be completed within 3-6 months, citizens must organize to determine need and how to accomplish, listed in no order of importance)

- a. Beautify closed alley between restaurant and professional building on south side of square
- b. Adult recreation leagues
- c. Christmas celebration
- d. Garden tour
- e. Kids street chalk art
- f. Fly-ins
- g. Sully "night out" with different themes: Vintage auto show, ice cream social, barbecue contest, lighted bike ride
- h. Bean bag toss tournament

3. SHORT TERM PROJECTS – 12 MONTH COMPLETION TIMEFRAME (listed in no order of importance)

- a. Establish non-profit foundation to accept gifts for projects
- b. Law enforcement-night time cop
- c. Playground equipment in central square park
- d. Playground equipment in city ballpark
- e. New sidewalks
- f. Fix sidewalks

4. MAJOR PROJECTS – 36 MONTH COMPLETION TIMEFRAME (will probably need some type of engineering and design assistance, listed in no order of importance)

- a. Bike trail/path in cooperation with Lynnville
- b. Resurface 1st Street
- c. Ballpark area upgrade-tennis court, skate park, Frisbee golf, dog park
- d. City square upgrade-stage/band shell, restrooms
- e. Splash park
- f. Community wireless network access
- g. General/grocery store
