The Sully City Council met for a work session at 7:00 p.m. on January 22, 2024, in the Council Chambers with Mayor Ben Ahrens presiding. Council Members present were Mary Carol Cross, Justin Van Soelen and Tim LeCompte. Council Member Jon Van Wyk and Council Member Dan Stouthammer were absent. Also, present were City Clerk Barbra Maasdam and Public Works Director Jeremy Behun.

Hometown Pride Committee representatives Julie Van Wyk and Shelby Shinkle presented a budgetary quote for playground equipment for their proposed next phase of the Ballpark Improvement Project. Installation of the playground equipment could be done in three phases to help offset the \$240,661 total project cost. The Committee continues to raise funds and will research and apply for available grants.

The council also reviewed the preliminary cost estimate for construction of parking areas and driveway replacement for the Ballpark Improvements Project drafted by Garden & Associates.

Council Members reviewed and discussed projected revenue and expenditures for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, to complete a draft budget to be considered for approval at a later meeting. Property tax levy rates were reviewed and discussed to be considered for approval at the regular February meeting.

The work session ended at 8:35 p.m.
